## Volunteer Position: Pricing

**Purpose:** As a Pricing Volunteer, you will help determine appropriate prices for donated items, ensuring they are fair, competitive, and aligned with ReStore standards. Your efforts will directly impact sales, helping to generate funds for Habitat for Humanity's mission of building homes and supporting communities.

**Shift Details:**

- Shifts typically last 3-4 hours, with morning and afternoon options available.
- Flexible scheduling is offered to accommodate your availability.

**Position Duties:**

- Evaluate donated items, including furniture, appliances, building materials, home décor, and more, to assess quality, condition, and value.
- Research pricing trends to set competitive and market-appropriate prices for items.
- Accurately label items with price tags and brief descriptions, ensuring clarity for customers.
- Identify unique or high-value items for special consideration or additional pricing review.
- Collaborate with staff to develop pricing strategies for items that require special expertise.
- Help maintain an organized workspace in the pricing area and assist with the placement of priced items on the sales floor.
- Uphold Habitat for Humanity's commitment to providing affordable products to the community.

**Qualifications and Skills:**

- Basic knowledge of retail pricing or a willingness to learn (training provided).
- Attention to detail and ability to assess the condition and value of various items.
- Strong organizational skills and ability to work independently or as part of a team.
- Physical ability to handle items (up to 25 lbs) and stand or move for extended periods.
- A positive and collaborative attitude.

**Important to Note:** Volunteers must be a minimum of 16 years of age. Volunteer Orientation and Safety Training is mandatory for new volunteers. All ReStore volunteers must provide and wear their own CSA approved steel toe boots.
