Habitat for Humanity Greater Ottawa Build Day is the most unique team-building opportunity! Your company can engage employees while investing in the community. In taking this step, your company has recognized the importance of supporting employee volunteerism while helping local families build strength, stability and self-reliance through affordable homeownership.

How to participate in a Habitat Build Day in a few easy steps:

1. You will be introduced to the Community Engagement Coordinator who will work with you to schedule a date for your team.
2. Your group contact will receive all of the information necessary to have a great build day, including a volunteer handbook and safety video.
3. Your group contact arranges for up to 10 people to participate in the day.
4. On your build day, your group arrives on site at 9 a.m. We provide your team with everything you need for the day, including tools, steel toe boots, hard hats and safety training. The day wraps up around 3:30 p.m.
5. Your team will be led through projects by Crew Leaders who are experienced construction volunteers.
6. Each volunteer receives a Habitat t-shirt, lunch, coffee, snacks, and team photos!
